- (a)&(b): During XI Five Year Plan, one IIM namely Rajiv Gandhi Indian Institute of Management (RGIIM), Shillong has already been established in Shillong (Meghalaya) which has commenced its academic session from 2008-09 and it has been decided to set up the remaining six (6) new IIMs at Rohtak (Haryana), Raipur (Chhattisgarh), Ranchi (Jharkhand), Tiruchirappalli (Tamil Nadu), Kashipur (Uttarakhand) & Udaipur (Rajasthan).
- (c): Historically, Indian Institute of Management (IIMs) have been established in different parts of the country on the demand for academia, industry and public in general.
