(b) if so, the reasons therefor along with the amount allocated for this project; and

(a) to (c): Nagapattinam-Velankanni new line work is a part of Tiruchchirappalli-Nagore- Karaikal with extension of Nagapattinam-Velankanni-Tiruturaipundi gauge conversion project. On this new line work, track linking has already been completed and engine rolling done. This new line will be commissioned in next 2-3 months after completion of residual works and authorisation of Comissioner of Railway Safety.

An outlay of Rs.35 crore has been proposed for the project during 2010-11.
