BASIC AMENITIES AT MUMBAI BASED RAILWAY STATION

- (a) whether lack of basic amenities at some of the Mumbai Railway Stations been brought to the notice of the Railways;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Railways to provide basic amenities in railway stations?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c): Forty five (45) representations were received during 2009-10 in respect of shortage of drinking water and for increase in seating arrangements. The issue regarding shortage of water supply has been taken up with Municipal Authorities for providing uninterrupted supply of drinking water. In addition, Station Masters have been directed to make alternative arrangements of drinking water for passengers in case of shortage thereof. Seating arrangements have been provided at all Railway Stations as per requirement.
