- (a) & (b): As per available figures, 22 cases for appointment on compassionate ground are pending in West Central Railway, Jabalpur. 03 cases are pending on account of litigation and the remaining cases are under process. The cases, other than those pending on account of litigation, are likely to be finalised by May, 2010.
- (c): Compassionate appointment is considered in favour of one eligible dependent family member of Railway servants who die in harness or retire prematurely on account of medical decategorisation.
