- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. At present 4 pairs of train services are running between Chennai and Tirupati as compared to 2 pairs of trains during the year 1996.
- (c) & (d): At present there is no proposal to introduce a train from Tambaram to Tirupati due to operational & resource constraints.
