(a) & (b): The Eleventh Five Year plan envisages the setting up of 30 Central Universities including 14 world class universities, 8 new Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs), 7 new Indian Institutes of Management(IIMs), 10 new National Institutes of Technology(NITs), 3 Indian Institutes of Science Education and Research(IISERs), 20 Indian Institutes of Information Technology(IITs) and 2 new Schools of Planning and Architecture (SPAs).
