- (c) whether there is any law to ban interview of children seeking admission in schools; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof ?

(a) to (d) Education is a concurrent subject and school education is primarily within the purview of the State Governments. The information about entrance examination for admission in pre-primary schools of States/UTs is not centrally monitored. It is for the concerned State Governments to regulate the matter.
