- (a) Indian Council of Agricultural Research does not have an Institute for Agro-chemical Research. However, there is a division of agricultural chemicals at Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi, which is a unit of ICAR.
- (b) Research on syntheses and development of new chemical molecules from botanical sources is undertaken. Formulation technology is another area of research.
