- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (b) The details of newly developed varieties of different crops alongwith productivity and pest resistance is enclosed as Annexure-I.
- (c) to (e): These varieties have been introduced into seed chain. The availability of different varieties is also a function of their acceptance and adoption by the farmers.
