- (c) No such proposal is under consideration at present.

- (e) GM crops have the advantage of various beneficial traits such as insect pest resistance, herbicide tolerance, virus resistance, tolerance to drought, cold and salinity conditions, nutritional enhancement, improved nitrogen use efficiency etc. All GM crops are required to undergo prescribed tests to establish that they are safe for human health and environment.
