(a) & (c): Proposals from State Governments including Nagaland, Kerala, Himachal Pradesh, West Bengal, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Orissa, Mizoram, Maharastra, Meghalaya, Gujarat, Haryana, etc have been received, offering land and other facilities for setting up of new Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs) in their States. Locations for new IIITs are yet to be decided. The process for setting up of new IIITs is already underway with the 'in principle' approval of the Planning Commission to set up new Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs) under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode having been conveyed.
