Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any State Government has sent any proposals to the Central Government for setting up of various vocational educational institutions on the basis of Public Private Partnership (PPP) particularly from the State Governments of Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details of the proposals and the Government's response thereto, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has made any guidelines for setting up and to run vocational educational institutions on the basis of PPP; and
- (d) If so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a) & (b): No such proposal has been received from the State Governments of Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh under the existing scheme of vocationalisation of secondary education. However under the Sub-Mission on Polytechnics, 300 Polytechnics are to be set up in public-private partnership (PPP) mode, but no proposal has been received from Maharashtra and U.P States under this scheme. A proposal for 53 polytechnics in PPP mode has been received from Andhra Pradesh.
- (c)&(d): No such guidelines have been issued under the scheme of vocationalisation of secondary education or Sub-Mission on Polytechnics.
