PURANDESWARI) (a) to (c): The concept for establishment of 14 Innovation Universities aiming at world class standards have been placed in the public domain at http:/www.education.nic.in/uhe/Universitiesconceptnote.pdf. (d) to (f): The States Governments of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Gujarat, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Orissa, Punjab, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal have offered certain sites for the establishment of the innovation universities. Close proximity to a large urban agglomeration with good connectivity and transport facilities are essential features of a site to be considered suitable for locating in innovation university. The Site Selection Committee has commenced the task of visiting the locations offered by State Governments for identifying suitable sites.
