UPGRADATION OF SABARMATI RAILWAY STATION

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Railways have any proposal for development of Sabarmati railway station;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the fund allocated for the purpose; and
- (c) the time by which the said railway station is likely to be upgraded?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c): Development/augmentation of passenger amenities at railway stations is an on-going process and the same is undertaken depending upon volume of passenger traffic handled and other relative priorities. Accordingly, developmental works at Sabarmati railway station have been completed in 2009-10 at a cost of Rs. 1.55 crore. These works include improvement to circulating area, waiting rooms, toilets, booking office and surface on platform no. 1; provision of Coach Guidance System, Train Display Board and modern furniture for waiting room and retiring room.
