- (c) the details of terms, conditions and qualifications fixed for NGOs in this regard?

## **Answer**

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The following schemes encourage the Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) to participate in environmental projects:
- 1. Environmental Research Promotion including National Natural Resources Management System (NNRMS);
- 2. Pollution Control Projects;
- 3. Conservation;
- 4. Environment Education, Awareness and Centres of Excellence Scheme;
- 5. Environment Information System (ENVIS)
- (d) Any registered voluntary/ professional/ Non-Governmental organization having proven credential, and experience in environmental/ social fields and registered under the Societies Registration Act for minimum three years and with audited accounts for the said period, have a properly constituted Managing Body with its powers, duties and responsibilities clearly defined and laid down in a written constitution/ by-laws and having a sound financial position to take up the project are eligible for submitting proposals for financial support from the Ministry of Environment & Forests under the above schemes.
