- (c) the present status of the implementation of the recommendations?

- (a): Yes.
- (b) & (c): The recommendations of the Valiathan Committee have been divided into following two parts:

Part "A"-recommendations not requiring structural changes (31 recommendations) and Part "B"- recommendations requiring structural changes through amendment in AllMS Act, Rules and Regulations (7 recommendations).

The present status of recommendations under Part "A" is as under:

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Accepted and implemented - 17

Accepted-in-principle - 10

Long term - Futuristic - 03

Not accepted - 01
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Since amendments in AllMS Act, Rules and Regulations have wider implications, a High Powered Committee comprising of eminent persons having experience in the field of administration and education has been constituted under the chairmanship of Secretary (H&FW) to examine recommendations under Part "B".
