(a) the number of PCOs opened in the country including rural areas during the last three years and till date, State-wise including Bihar;

(b) whether all the said PCOs are working properly;

(c) if not, the number of PCOs lying closed and the steps taken for re-starting them; and

(d) the scheme being formulated for providing quality telecom services in the country?

(a) The data of Public Call Offices (PCOs) excluding Village Public Telephones (VPTs) is maintained circle-wise (not State-wise) by Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL)/Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited (MTNL).

The total number of circle-wise PCOs opened in the country (including rural areas as well as Bihar) for the period 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09 and 2009-10 are given in the Annexure.

- (b) Yes, Madam. Generally PCOs are working satisfactorily.
- (c) Does not arise in view of (b) above.

(d) Quality of Telecom Service is being monitored as per the benchmarks prescribed by Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI).
