**Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the annual growth rate of gross domestic product for the year 2009-10 has been negative;
- (b) if so, the projected estimates at the beginning of the current year and the estimates finally achieved;
- (c) the details of contribution made by agriculture, infrastructure and service sectors respectively to GDP; and
- (d) the growth rate of employment during the current year based on revised GDP growth?

**Answer**

(a) to (d): No, Sir. The annual growth rate of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at factor cost at constant (2004-05) prices during 2009-10 is estimated to be 7.2 percent as per the Advance Estimates of Annual National Income released by the Central Statistical Organization on 08-02-2010. The contribution made by agriculture, industry and service sector to GDP during the year 2009-10 is envisaged at 14.6%, 28.2% and 57.2% respectively. The Planning Commission has not conducted any survey to estimate the growth rate of employment during the current year.
