(a) (b) (c) & (d) There is no proposal for establishment of Elephant Conservation Park in the country including Karnataka State. However, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of `Project Elephant`, 26 Elephant Reserves have been notified all over the country and financial assistance is provided to the states under this scheme. State-wise list of the Elephant Reserves in India is enclosed at Annexure. In addition, an Elephant Rehabilitation Centre at Bir Shikargah in Haryana has also been established under this scheme with the objective of providing shelter for seized elephants from circuses etc.
