(a) to (c): Ministry of Culture through Archaeological Survey of India receives proposals for assistance in conservation from State Governments from time to time .

Some proposals received from the State Government of Bihar for conservation/beautification of cultural heritage in rural areas have been taken up with the cooperation of the State Government of Bihar and are at different stages of implementation.

- 1. Buddhist Stupa at Kesariya, District East Chamaparan
- 2. Tomb of Makhdoom Shah Daulat & Ibrahim Khan, Maner, District Patna
- 3. Rohatas Garh Fort at Rohtas, District Rohtas
- 4. Tomb of Sher Shah Suri, Sasaram, District Rohtas.

In addition to the above, maintenance of conservation of following monuments in Bihar have been taken up on deposit work.

- 1. Golghar at Patna, Distt. Patna
- 2. Kameshwar Singh, Darbhanga Sanskrit University, Dist. Darbhanga
- 3. Mahobodhi Temple, Bodhgaya, Dist. Gaya.
