- (a) to (d) The Ministry of Culture implements a scheme of financial assistance for the Preservation and Development of Cultural Heritage of Himalayas. The objective of the scheme is to :
- i). study and research all aspects of cultural heritage;
- ii). collection of objects of art and craft and documentation of cultural artifacts including the folk, music, dance and literature;
- iii). dissemination through audio-visual programmes of art and culture;
- iv). training in traditional and folk arts; and
- v). assisting in and setting up of museums and libraries, etc.

Under the scheme, Voluntary organizations, institutions, societies, trusts registered under the Society's Registration Act 1860 and individuals, etc. can apply.
