- (a) & (b) As per the information provided by Kerala State Pollution Control Board, between the years 2002 to 2008, the pollution levels in the Chalakudy river have been monitored and observed to be within acceptable limits for bathing class standards in respect of the parameters such as pH, Dissolved Oxygen (DO), Bio-chemical Oxygen Demand (BOD) and Fecal coliform.
- (c) & (d) The Government has not received any representation from Chalakudy River Action Council.
