MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT(SHRI PRADEEP JAIN `ADITYA`)

(a): The Ministry of Rural Development through the State Governments and Union Territory Administration implements the major schemes namely, Mahatama Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), Swarnjayanti Gram Swarajgar Yojana (SGSY), Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY), Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP), National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) and Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC) in rural areas of the country including Karnataka.

(b)&(c): 13 complaints were received under MGNREGA from Karnataka State. The complaints and suggestions are received from the individuals/Non Governmental Organisations (NGOs) are immediately sent to the concerned State Governments for necessary action and remedial measures.
