- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government in this regard?

Answer

- (a) & (b): The Leaders at the G-20 meeting at Pittsburgh expressed concern about the poorest countries having little economic cushion to protect vulnerable populations from calamity, particularly as the international financial crisis followed soon after the global increase in food prices.
- (c) & (d): The Pittsburgh Summit designated the G-20 as the premier forum for international economic cooperation which has been welcomed by the Government.
