(d) the names of crops for which applications were filed?

(a)&(b): Yes, Madam. The Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmer's Rights Authority (PPV&FRA) has already notified 21 species covering 17 crops namely Bread Wheat, Rice, Maize, Sorghum, Pearl Millet, Chickpea, Pigeon pea, Green gram, Black gram, Field pea, Kidney bean, Lentil, Cotton, Jute, Sugarcane, Turmeric and Ginger for granting plant variety protection after completion of various requirements under the Plant Protection Varieties and Farmers Rights (PPV & FR) Act, 2001.

(c)&(d): The Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Authority had received 1682 applications till 31st March, 2010 for registration of plant varieties in crops namely Bread wheat, Rice, Maize, Sorghum, Pearl Millet, Chickpea, Pigeon pea, Green gram, Black gram, Field pea, Kidney bean, Lentil, Cotton, Jute, Sugarcane.
