## Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the names of the States where wheat, paddy, cotton, pulses, oilseeds and sugarcane crops are cultivated;

(b) the average production of these crops in each State;

(c) whether the rate of production of the said crops is different in each State; and

(d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise alongwith the reasons for the difference in their production rate?

## Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (PROF. K.V. THOMAS)

(a)&(b): The details of States/UTs where wheat, paddy, cotton, pulses, oilseeds and sugarcane crops are cultivated alongwith the State-wise average production of these crops are given in Annexure-I.

(c)&(d): Yes, Madam. State-wise details of average productivity(yield) of the above crops are given in Annexure-II.

The productivity of different crops depend on a number of factors such as soil fertility, use of fertilizers, rainfall pattern, weather conditions, quality/variety of seeds etc. Due to regional variation in these factors, variation in the production and productivity in different areas/States have been observed.
