The Rastriya Sam Vikas Yojana (RSVY) is being implemented in 147 districts from 2003-04. The list of districts covered under the RSVY is at Annexe. At present this Scheme has been subsumed in the Backward Regions Grant Fund programme and is also proposed for closure from December 2009 as most of the districts have claimed their total allocation of Rs.45 crore each. As such there is no proposal under consideration of the Government to extend RSVY to other districts of the country.
