- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a)&(b): Yes, Madam. The Department of Agriculture & Cooperation has been implementing two Centrally Sponsored Schemes namely,
- (i) Integrated Development of Horticulture in North Eastern States, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand (TMNE) and
- (ii) National Horticulture Mission (NHM) in the remaining States for holistic development of horticulture including promotion of cocoa cultivation.
- (c)&(d): Central Plantation Crops Institute, Indian Council of Agricultural Research has recommended spraying of insecticides like Fenthion @ 50ml in 100 litres of water or Dimethoate @ 160 ml in 100 litres of water for effective control of mealy bugs in cocoa plantations.
