- (a) & (b) Government has recently approved a proposal for enhancement of number of Junior Research Fellowships during 11th Five Year Plan Period (2007-2012) in basic science subjects including Life Sciences.
- (c) At present, 8370 Junior / Senior Research Fellows are pursuing research with CSIR support. The financial allocation / expenditure incurred on research fellowship schemes of CSIR during the last three years and the current year is as under:
