- (a) whether the Government has signed Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with National Seeds Corporation Limited (NSCL) and State Farms Corporation of India (SFCI) to increase seed production;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the total seed production by such corporations during the last three years and the current year, corporation-wise and yearwise?

Answer

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The Government has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 15th March 2010 with both the National Seeds Corporation Limited (NSC) and the State Farms Corporation of India limited (SFCI) for the financial year 2010-11. Higher seed production targets have been given to both Corporations for 2010-11 compared to 2009-10 i.e., 19 lakh quintals of seed over 15 lakh quintals for NSC and 6 lakhs quintals of seed against 5.75 lakh quintals for SFCI.
- (c): The position of total seed production by NSC and SFCI is given below:
