## THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRIS. M. KRISHNA)

- (a): Government are aware that concerns have been expressed by some countries that some areas and organisations within Pakistan provide sanctuaries for terrorists for cross border activities.
- (b): At the meeting between Prime Minister of India and President of Pakistan on 16-09-2006 in Havana both leaders decided to put in place a Joint Anti-Terrorism Mechanism to identify and implement counter-terrorism initiatives and investigations. Four meetings under the Joint Anti Terrorism mechanism were held before the Composite Dialogue was paused after the terrorist attack on Mumbai on 26-11-2008.
