- (a) whether the Railways propose to lease out some of its real-estate assets;
- (b) if so, the details worked out so far, zone-wise; and
- (c) the objectives of such lease?

(a) to (c): In order to mobilize additional financial resources, Indian Railways have set up Rail Land Development Authority (RLDA) through an Act of Parliament to undertake suitable development of its vacant land not required by railways for its own immediate future operational needs, by leasing it on long term basis. 135 sites have been entrusted to RLDA so far, in this regard. Zone-wise details of the sites are given in Appendix. Vacant railway land is also leased/licensed for purposes connected with Railway working viz. shops, coal dumps, steel yards, bulk oil installation etc. This yields additional revenues for Railways.
