- (a) This Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways. As per the policy of this Ministry, roads which help opening up large tracks of backward areas and hilly regions are, inter-alia, considered while declaration of new National Highways. There is no specific policy for road connectivity in the Hilly areas.
