The Joint Admission Board (JAB), which is responsible for conducting of the Indian Institute of Technology Joint Entrance Examination (IIT-JEE), has informed that there have been some error in instructions in some of the questions in the IIT-JEE, 2010. The JAB, consisting inter-alia of the Directors and Chairmen, JEE, of all the IITs, in an emergency meeting held on 02.05.2010, unanimously observed that the situation does not warrant holding of any re-examination and that the remedial measure outlined below will adequately address / redress the concerns of students arising out of the present situation:-
