(a)to(b): National Plan of Action for Children, was prepared in 2005 in consultation with concerned Ministries/Departments, States/Union Territory Governments, Non Governmental Organizations and experts. It includes goals, objectives and strategies in Child Survival, Child Development, Child Protection and Child Participation. It has identified priority areas for actions such as reducing malnutrition among children, reducing Infant Mortality Rate and Maternal Mortality Rate, achieving 100% registration of births, universalisation of early childhood care and development, quality education for all children, improving water and sanitation, abolition of child labour etc.
