- (d) if so, the corrective measures proposed to strengthen and widen the roads in Jharkhand?

- (a), (b) & (d): No, Sir. The National Highways (NHs) in Jharkhand are generally in traffic worthy condition except some sections of NH-80 and NH-75(Ext.). Improvement of affected stretches is taken up in phases depending upon traffic needs, inter-se priority and availability of funds.
