**Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether as per data revealed by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), a large number of colleges across the country have not renewed their ratings;
- (b) if so, the details of such colleges, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has now made accreditation as a mandatory for all colleges in the country; and
- (d) if so, its likely impact on colleges which have not renewed their ratings?

(a) and (b) According to the information furnished by National Assessment and Accreditation Council, out of 4094 colleges so far assessed and accredited by it, the validity period of 5 years is over in respect of 2028 colleges. The State-wise number of such colleges is at Annexure.
