(a) to (c) The principle of equity and Common but Differentiated Responsibilities & Respective Capabilities as enshrined in the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) guides the actions of all countries including India in addressing climate change. No specific study of the matter and in particular, equity of carbon space has been undertaken by the Government.
