(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the number of National Highways repaired / widened and strengthened by the Government during the last two years;

(d) the present status of improvement of the dilapidated National Highways of various States, State-wise and National Highway-wise including Uttar Pradesh alongwith the funds allocated for the purpose;

(e) the details of the works undertaken regarding widening / repair of the National Highways and construction of bridges during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise and National Highway-wise;and

(f) the steps taken by the Government for early completion of such projects?

(c) & (d) The development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs) is a continuous process and all NHs are being kept in trafficworthy condition within the available resources. The State-wise details of number of NHs including Uttar Pradesh, on which works of repairing, widening and strengthening have been taken up during the last two years, i.e. 2008-09 & 2009-10 are at Annexure-I. These works are in various stages of award / implementation. The state -wise details of funds allocated for development of National Highways during the last two years are at Annexure-II.

(e) The State-wise and NH-wise details of works undertaken for widening, repairing of NHs & construction of bridges during the last three years and the current year are at Annexure-III.

(f) The progress of the projects is periodically monitored at various levels and necessary corrective actions are taken from time to time.
