- (a) whether any bridge on National Highway No. 17 has been closed for heavy vehicles;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor and the corrective action taken by the Government/NHAI in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to construct any new bridge to ease traffic movement on the said NH;and
- (d) if so, the details in this regard alongwith the time by which construction of the new bridge is likely to be completed?

- (a) & (b) Government of Goa has not allowed heavy traffic on the rehabilitated Zuari bridge on NH-17 based on the load testing and recommendations of Central Road Research Institute (C.R.R.I.).
- (c) Yes, Sir.
- (d) The new bridge over river Zuari on NH-17 is proposed under National Highways Development Project (NHDP) Phase-Ill as part of the project of the 4 laning of NH-17 in the State of Goa. The bridge is likely to be completed by May, 2014.
