- (a): Petronet LNG Limited (PLL) is setting up an LNG terminal at Kochi, Kerala. The Project is under implementation and is progressing as per the schedule. As on date, approximately 35% work has been completed.
- (b): Estimated cost of the Project is Rs.3600 crore (approximately).
- (c): Mechanical completion of the Project is scheduled in December 2011 and the Project is expected to be commissioned in the first quarter of 2012.
