- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken to protect the interests of the employees?

- (a): No Madam. There is no move at present in Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL) to shift its existing Service Centre office located at Patna (Bihar) to Durgapur (West Bengal).
