- (b) whether the students of these institutes are required to undergo on the job training for completing their course study; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

MINISTER OF THE STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL)

- (a): There are 72 Aircraft Maintenance Engineering (AME) Training Institutes approved by the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) for conducting Aircraft Maintenance Engineering Course in the country. The list of AME Training Institutes, with their permitted intake is annexed.
- (b) and (c): Yes, Madam. On-Job-Training is part of AME Training curriculum. The students of AME Training Institutes are required to undergo six months On-Job-Training in an Aircraft Maintenance Organization.
