(a), (b) & (c): Government of India has not received any formal proposal either from the State Government of Tamil Nadu, in accordance with the Policy for Greenfield airports, for setting up of a Greenfield airport at Sriperambudur in TamilNadu. However, on the request of Government of Tamil Nadu, Airports Authority of India had conducted a pre-feasibility study for development of a new Greenfield Airport at Sriperumbudur near Chennai and submitted its report to the Government of Tamil Nadu.
