**Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government proposes to establish super/speciality hospitals in various States in the country; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

**Answer**

(a) & (b) Yes. The Government has approved setting up of six AIIMS-like institutions in the States of Bihar (Patna), Chhattisgarh (Raipur), Madhya Pradesh (Bhopal), Orissa (Bhubaneswar), Rajasthan (Jodhpur) and Uttarakhand (Rishikesh) under the first phase of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY). The Government has also approved setting up of two more institutions, one each in the State of Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal in the second phase of PMSSY.
