(a) the number of posts of doctors and staff reserved for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in Government hospitals of Delhi; and

(b) the steps being taken by the Government to fill up the said vacancies?

(a) & (b) Health being a State subject such information is not maintained centrally. However, in respect of the Central Government Hospitals in Delhi namely Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, Safdarjung Hospital and LHMC Hospital & Associated Hospitals, the number of posts of doctors and staff reserved for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes are 15% and 7.5% respectively.

Action is taken from time to time to fill up the vacant posts as per the laid down procedures.
