- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the guidelines formulated in this regard; and

Answer

MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRIS. JAIPAL REDDY)

- (a): The floor area ratio is a part of the Development Control Regulations of towns/cities and comes within the purview of State Governments/Development Authorities/Urban Local Bodies concerned. Changing the floor area ratio is to be decided by these authorities.
- (b): Does not arise.
- (c): Relaxation in floor-area ratio helps in constructing additional floor space which can accommodate the growing needs of the population, provided other infrastructure facilities are available.
