- (b) whether all the projects are likely to be completed within the sanctioned/ prescribed outlay;
- (c) if not, whether the Government proposes to enhance the allocation; and
- (d) if so, the steps taken in this regard?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI PRATIK PRAKASHBAPU PATIL)

- (a): The current estimates for holding Commonwealth Games, 2010 at Delhi as of now are Rs. 9865 crore.
- (b): No, Sir. The cost of some projects has increased over the initially approved estimates.
- (c) & (d): Yes, Sir. While approval of competent authority has been obtained for revised cost estimates of some projects, the revised cost estimates of remaining projects are under the process for approval.
