(a) Following funds has been provided to the State of Karnataka during last three years for educational development of Minority students under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) Programme - Rs. 297.25 lakh (2009-10) and Rs.217.50 lakh (2008-09). No funds were provided during 2007-08. Under Remedial Coaching Scheme for SC/ST/OBC (non creamy layer) and Minority Communities of University Grants Commission an amount of Rs. 8.49 lakh was given as assistance to 5 colleges in Karnataka during 2008-09.
