- (a) whether the places where the sports persons and participants are likely to be housed during the Commonwealth Games have been identified; and
- (b) if so, the details of the number of sports persons anticipated to arrive for the event and their stay arrangements?

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. About 8000 sports persons are expected for the Commonwealth Games, 2010 and they would be housed at Games Village, which is being developed by Delhi Development Authority at a site adjacent to the Akshardham Temple, off the NH 24. The Village would have all the modern amenities for the sportspersons as per the requirements of Commonwealth Games Federation.
